General Guidelines for Buying Sustainably-Raised Eggs and Meats

Consider where you shop

Whenever possible, support local and regional farms by purchasing from farmers' markets, food cooperatives, and stores that offer locally produced meats, dairy products, and eggs. Or—even better—buy directly from farmers. Be sure to ask questions about how the meats you buy are produced.

Read labels carefully

Unless labeled otherwise, eggs and meats in your supermarket are typically from a factory farm-type operation. On meat packaging, look for labels that say: "organic," "pastured," "free range," "hormone free," or "grass fed". "Pastured" indicates the chickens and sheep were literally placed in a grass pasture. Hogs need to be outside with plenty of space and fresh air; however, grazing on grass is not essential to their diet. Pastured birds graze on grass and eat bugs while still being supplemented with some grain. This difference in diet impacts the final flavor, color, and nutritional attributes of the eggs. By purchasing meat, eggs, and produce from local farmers, you know how your food was raised.

Be a conscious consumer

Know where your food comes from and how and by whom it was raised or produced. Ask your local grocery store and restaurants to offer sustainably produced meats—and support those that do!

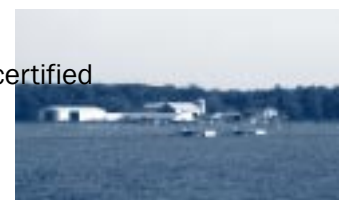

FACTORY FARM FACTS TO CONSIDER

The number of new and bigger concentrated animal feeding operations, commonly called factory farms or mega-farms, continues to grow in Ohio. These industrialized facilities are a stark contrast to traditional farm operations. Rows of these football field-sized buildings confine hundreds, thousands—even millions—of animals in cramped cages. Exempt from Ohio's cruelty laws, these animals can spend their entire lives in crates and cages—some so small they can't even walk, turn around, or completely lie down. Computers control the lighting and temperature conditions. Feed laced with hormones and antibiotics is commonly dispensed on a rigorous schedule. The biggest byproduct is pathogen-rich manure, and some facilities produce as much waste as entire cities. Family farms are disappearing—replaced by corporate factory farms—at an alarming rate. Livestock production in Ohio is now concentrated in fewer, but much larger farms.

Antibiotics are commonly added to the feed of factory farm animals. Scientists are discovering that this overuse and misuse of antibiotics is leading to bacterial resistance—creating a potential human health crisis if antibiotics become ineffective in treating bacterial infections. Congress is currently considering a bill which would phase out the use of medically important antibiotics in animals in order to protect these vitally important drugs used in human medicine.

In the United States, factory farms generate approximately 130 times the waste as do humans—five tons for each person.

Factory farms can pollute the air with ammonia, hydrogen sulfide, and particulate matter, which are linked to human health impacts. U.S. EPA tests showed that manure-laden exhaust from one Ohio egg farm was so dirty, it should be regulated like a power plant or factory. Despite these facts, Ohio EPA has yet to require air pollution controls on factory farms in Ohio.

According to a 2002 Ohio State University survey, 71% of Ohioans surveyed agreed or strongly agreed that "large-scale poultry and livestock facilities pose a serious threat to water and stream quality in Ohio." Fifty seven percent agreed or strongly agreed that "there needs to be increased regulation of livestock production in Ohio to protect the environment," and 59% agreed or strongly agreed that "large-scale poultry and livestock production facilities in rural areas are a threat to rural quality of life."
